This letter is to advise that Division II of the Region IV Missouri Supreme Court Disciplinary Committee has completed its investigation of the complaints you filed against Alice Wasson and Trisha Lacey. Based upon that investigation, we have found probable cause to believe that Alice Wasson and Trisha Lacey violated one or more specific rules of professional conduct and we have issued a written admonition to both Ms. Lacey and Ms. Wasson concerning their violation of those rules. The admonitions have been accepted by Ms. Lacey and Ms. Wasson. As a result, we are closing our files in these matters.

Public access to the letter of admonition is governed by Rule 5.31 of the Missouri Supreme Court Rules, which provides that the letter of admonition shall be available to the public from the Office of the Chief Disciplinary Counsel in Jefferson City, Missouri.
